Changes to the school immunization requirements for the 2018-2019 school year are as follows:

1. Hepatitis A (2 doses) is now **required** for kindergarten to 4th grade, 6th grade, and 12th grade.
2. One dose of meningococcal conjugate vaccine is **required** for 6th grade and a booster dose of the meningitis vaccine is **required** for students entering the 12th grade.
3. Entering 6th grade students are also **required** to receive a Tdap booster, and a second Chicken pox vaccination.
4. HPV has been added as a recommendation for grade 6-12.
5. Annual influenza (flu) has been added as a recommendation for all ages.
