# **SENIORS** Indiana County Bicentennial Scholarship

The Indiana County Bicentennial Scholarship provides a need-based scholarship opportunity for incoming freshmen students from select counties across the state of Indiana. Eligibility for the program is based on financial need and Indiana county of residence. No additional application is required. However, students from eligible counties must <u>submit</u> a FAFSA by April 15, 2018 to be considered.

Qualifying students will receive a scholarship of up to \$2,500 annually toward the direct cost of attendance at Indiana University. Students admitted for the fall of 2016 were the first to be considered for the Indiana County Bicentennial Scholarship. Ohio County is a bicentennial county this year.

Students need to apply by November 1st to be considered for many of Indiana University's scholarships. If students have questions, please have them email Ms. Sauerhage.
