DRIVER'S ED

RSHS offers the driving instruction portion of Driver's Education. The fee for the driving portion is \$250. Students **MUST** first complete the classroom portion online before enrolling. You may sign up in the HS Office until June 11th, at the Superintendent's Office (Mrs. Brown) June 14th thru July 16th and again at the HS Office beginning again on July 19th.

Any student needing to reserve a parking space for next school year can come to the office.

The cost for a parking permit will be \$5.00. Funds for next school year CANNOT be collected this school year. You can pay the \$5.00 fee and pick up a permit in the HS Office on OPEN HOUSE NIGHT or the first day of next school year.
