Our class now has a free 30 day trial (hopefully longer!) of IXL. Your child should be familiar with this program from 1st grade. To access it, you must go to www.ixl.com. If you try to go through our school website, it will not work. Your user name is the child's first name last name181 (no spaces or capitals). For example: heatherrace181 Everyone's password is 1234. Contact me if you have problems. When doing a lesson on IXL, you need to reach a SmartScore of at least 80. You can go higher if you want.
